

Call for Papers

The **12th International Conference of the French Association of Experimental Economics** (ASFEE), will be organized by Groupe d'Analyse et de Théorie Economique (GATE) on **30th June-1**st **July 2022**.

The conference will provide an opportunity for researchers to present results of laboratory and field experiments. It will cover all topics regarding behavioral and experimental economics, such as decision theory, game theory, institutions and markets, neuroeconomics, economic psychology and others.
